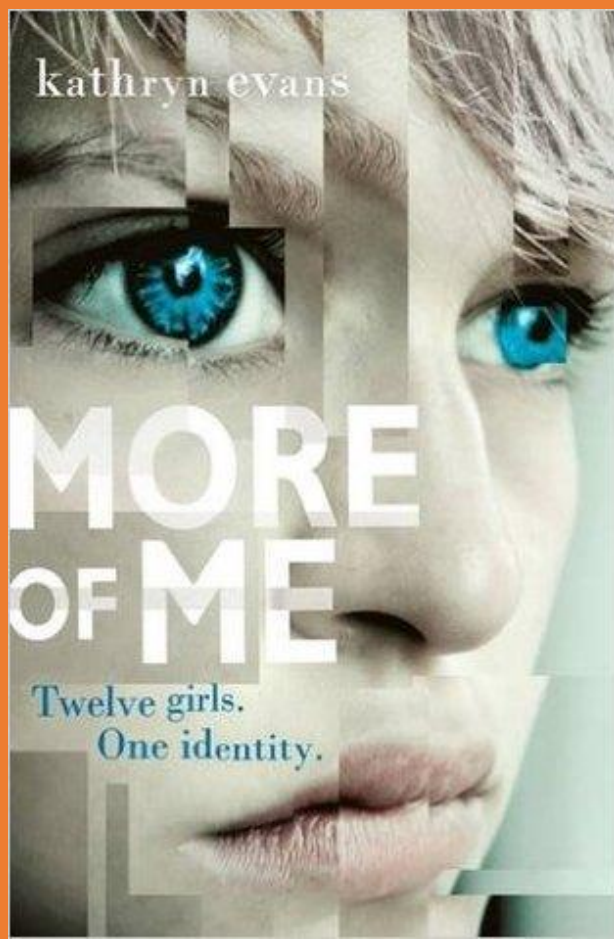
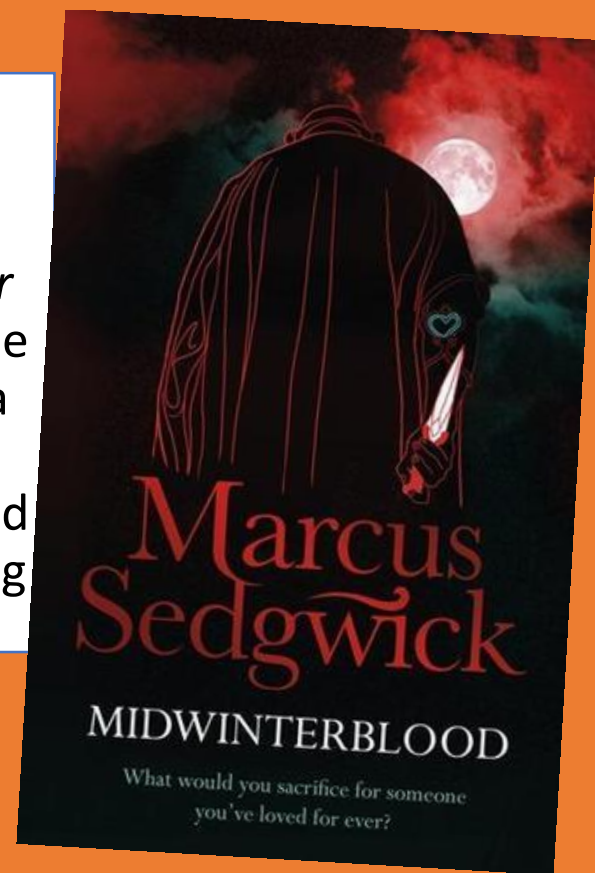


# Weekly Reading Recommendations
